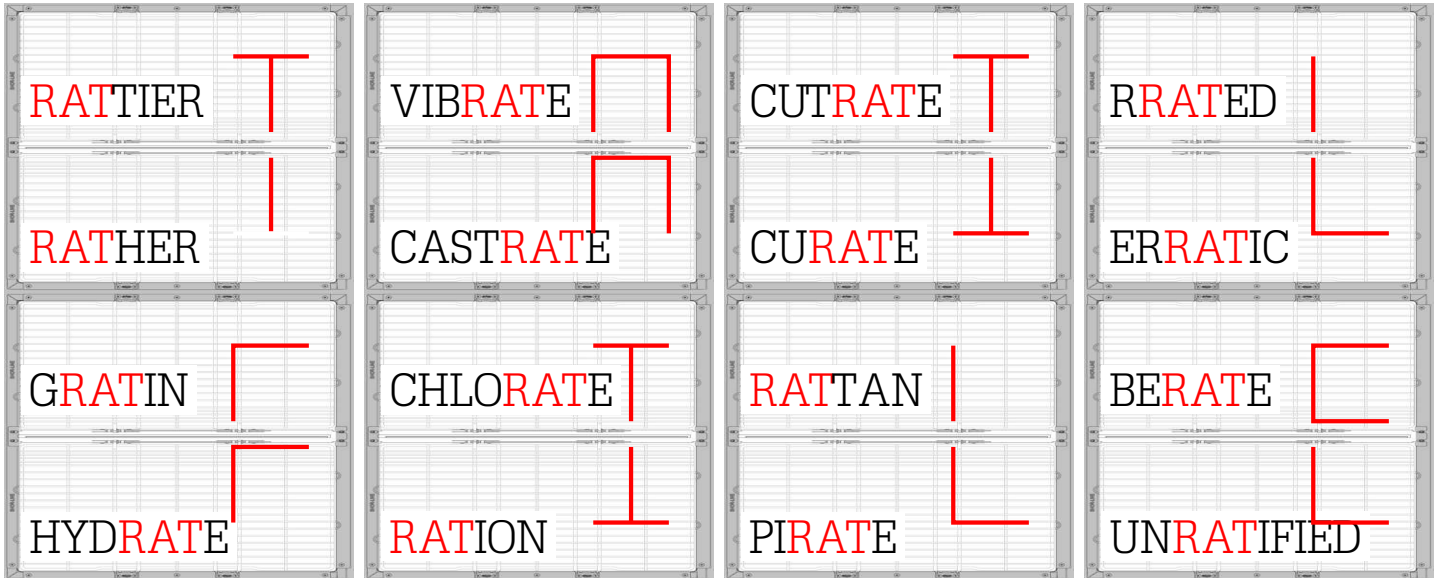


MISSING RATS SOLUTION
