

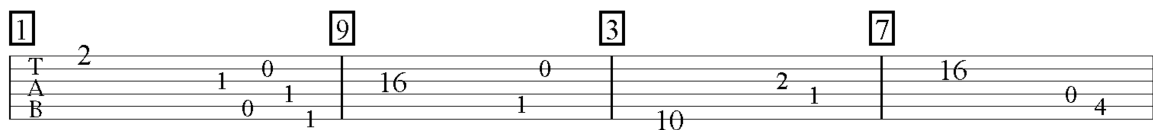
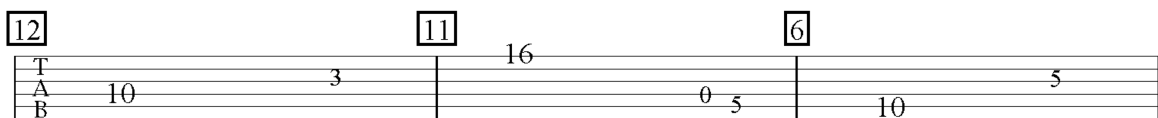
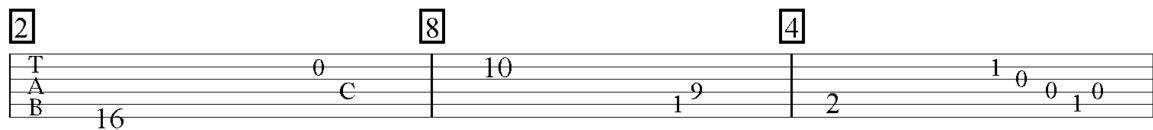
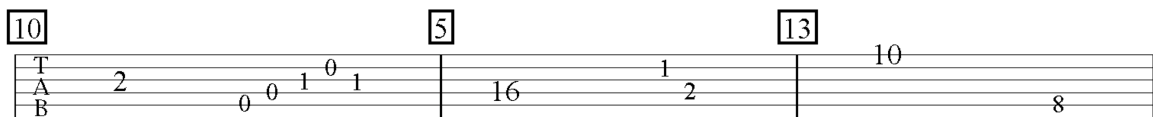


Jazz Witches
