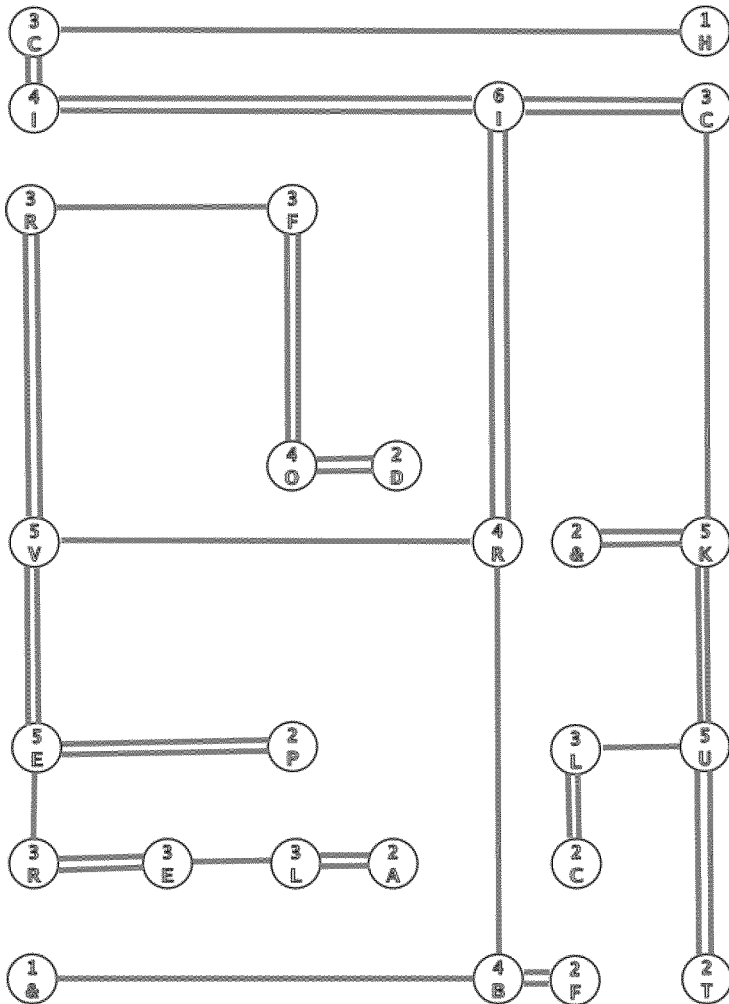


Puzzled Pint - & - Hints and Answers

4. PARTIAL ANSWER Brick

1. As you match edges of the triangle, tape them together to form a 3D shape.

3. **PARTIAL ANSWER** SEE LETTERS AT INTERSECTIONS OR ENDS. DRAW LINES BETWEEN, GUIDED BY NONSENSE. DRAW NEW LETTERS. SPELL NEW WORD.
4. Notice how the word bank words visually make an
