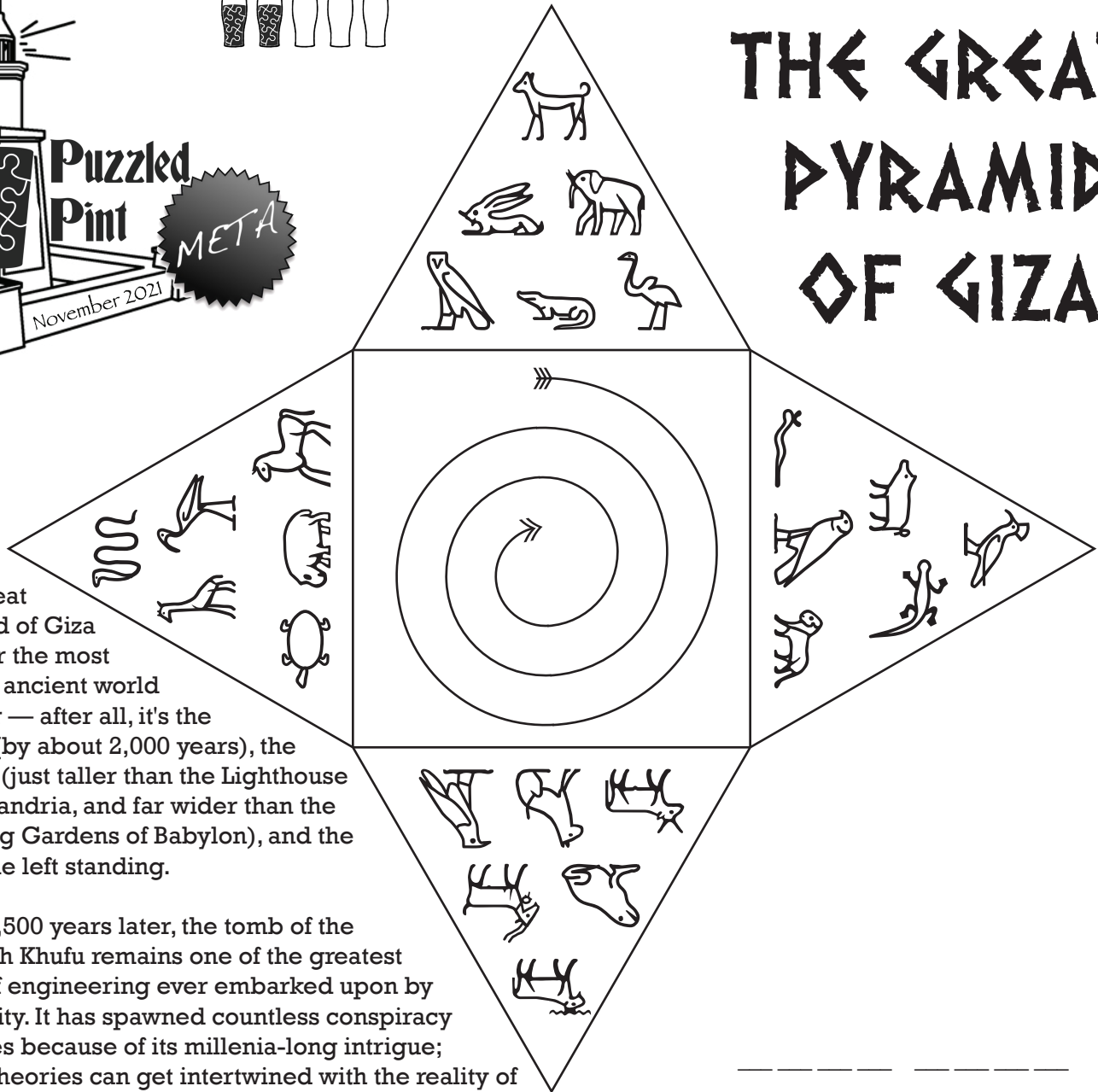




THE GREAT PYRAMID OF GIZA
