Each trivia question contains some anagrammed names/phrases. The unaltered questions and answers are:

What city whose nicknames include "**The Windy City**", "**Second City**", and "**Chi-Town**" recorded its coldest temperature ever in early 1985 at **-27°F**? (CHICAGO)

What rock group lead by sisters **Ann** and **Nancy** released their self-titled comeback album in 1985 producing hits such as **Never** and the number one **These Dreams**? (HEART)

Who met with **Mikhail Gorbachev** for the first time at the **Geneva Summit** in 1985 in an attempt to deal with the **Cold War**? (RONALD REAGAN)

The 1985 movie "**A View to a Kill**" takes its title from a short story by **Ian Fleming**, but like some other installments of the series, none of the plot. Who is the protagonist of the series? (JAMES BOND)

British scientists studying in the **South Pole** in 1985 discovered a hole in what **layer**? (OZONE)

What championship held each year in **London** did **Boris Becker** win in 1985 at **17** years old, becoming the youngest male ever to do so? (WIMBLEDON)

HEATER (HEART + E)

SNOOZE (OZONE + S)

The extra letters, taken in picture order, spell the answer **GENIUS**.
