

# PINT BY NUMBERS

Puzzled Pint turns 5 this month! And what better way to celebrate than with one of Portland's specialties: craft beer! Or, in this case, beer crafts!

Center a pint glass over each number that hasn't gotten too drunk (i.e. that's still upright), and trace around the bottom of the glass. Make a dot wherever a circle intersects a paintbrush. One of the circles has been drawn to give you a size reference.

Then label each dot with a letter: Use the brush color to select the right word from below, then take a letter from that word as specified by the number at the center of the intersecting circle. If circle #1 intersects a blue paintbrush, you would put the first letter of the blue word below at the point of intersection. If circle #7 and a yellow paintbrush intersect, you would use the 7th letter of the yellow word.
