- A long, long, long time **AGES**
- Greetings on a pirate ship **AHOYS**
- Swap one for another **TRADE**
- Not tender **TOUGH**
- Nikon product **CAMERA**
- Some D&D monsters **OGRES**
- Change, as a dress's length **ALTER**
- It was mapped in 2003 **GENOME**
- Gives a check to, say **PAYS**
- Breakfast bread **TOAST**
- Care provider **NURSE**
- Desert transport, maybe **CAMEL**
- Fancy neckwear **ASCOT**
