

## Parking Lot SOLUTION

This puzzle is based off Think Fun's Rush Hour (<a href="http://www.thinkfun.com/rushhour">http://www.thinkfun.com/rushhour</a>). If you're not familiar with the company, they produce many great games and brainteasers for children and adults.

- 1. The goal of each puzzle is to move the cars forwards and backwards to allow the red car to escape the parking lot through the hole on the right side of the board. There are five puzzles here, each solvable in fewer than 12 moves.
- 2. Once each puzzle is solved, read the uncovered letters (spaces with no car/truck on them).
- 3. Put together, the message reads: ORIGIN POSITIONS OF ORANGE PINK GRAY BROWN BLACK AND PURPLE CARS.
- 4. Take the orange cars from all five puzzles, and superimpose them on one board. They are in the configuration of a letter C. If you do the same for pink, gray, brown, black, and purple in order, you'll spell the puzzle's solution: CAUGHT.
