




**Part 1: U** The **intersections** are gridlocked! U H8 2 W8, so solve the grid below to unlock what U do next...




#### The Rules

Within a guessed word, each letter is shaded to show how it corresponds to a letter located...



The Rules are applied in top-down priority order. For example, if a letter is found both in the guessed word in a different position AND also in a different word, it will be coloured white.

#### **Guessed words:**



For example, the last clue (BONUS) shows:

- There is no **B** anywhere in the puzzle.
- There is at least one **O**, but not in word #4 and not in the 2nd position of any word.
- There is at least one **N** in word #4, but not in the 3rd position.
- There is at least one **U** in the 4th position of a different word in the puzzle.
- There is at least one **S**, but not in word #4 and not in the 5th position of any word.


**Part 2: Double-U** U went the wrong way, so now U have to *double back*! The doubled letters in the solution grid will reveal what too many of those U's can leave U in.




# The When-V of All of Your Friends (1/2)



Irene, Val, and Xavier are jealous that you managed to climb up on top of the massive clock that you found lying face up in the strange store. **From their perspectives**, they can barely see the side of the raised numerals that **dot** the clock's outer edge. Too vexed to **dash** about, they stay at their initial positions and call out instructions for you to rotate the clock face so they can get a better view.

# The When-V of All of Your Friends (2/2)



Irene: Turn it 4 hours to the left (clockwise)!

Val: Turn it 2 hours to the right!


Xavier: Turn it 3 hours to the left for me.

Val: Go back one hour to the right. Irene: 5 hours to the right, please.


Xavier: Turn it 2 more hours to the right. Val: The clock is right where I need it. Irene: 5 hours to the right, please!

Xavier: 2 hours to the left and then I'm done. Val: Could you turn it back 2 hours to the right? Val: Oh, and then 3 more hours to the right!

Irene: One more hour to the right, and I think we're all done.



After they **each separately** unlock mysteries of the clock from their own perspectives, Irene, Val, and Xavier have the **time** to help you discover what kind of store this is and what the puzzle is missing.






### ZZkd What the X goin' on?

- Miss Scarlett did not use the wrench or the knife.



- 6. You express boredom while you watch a <u>crustacean</u> try to <u>breed</u>.







### **How Meta!?**
