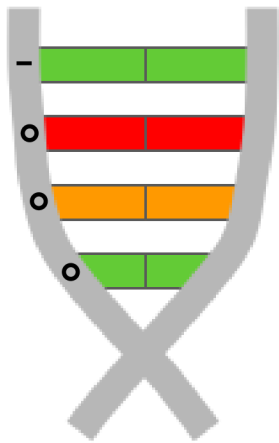


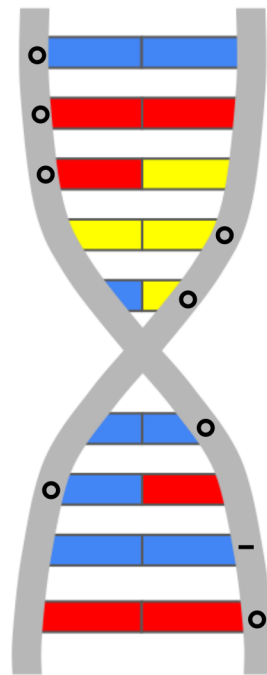
# The Nobel Prize in Medicine



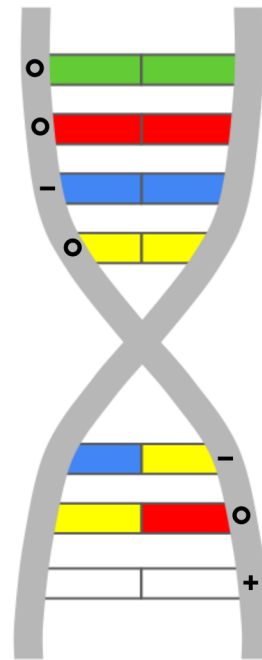

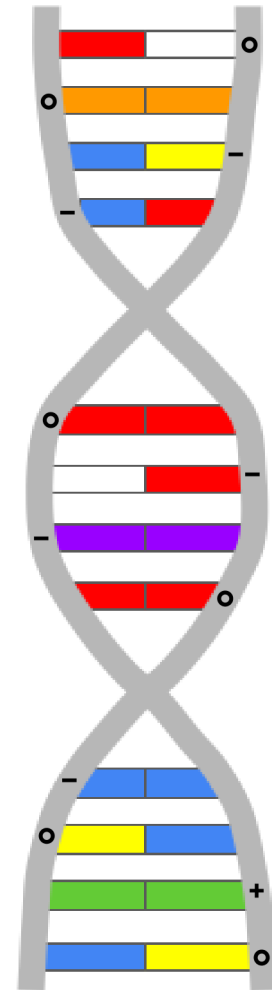
