

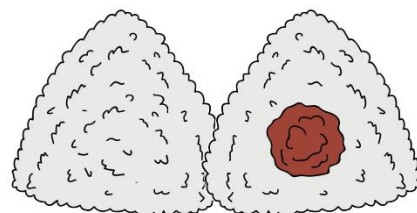


ONIGIRI
