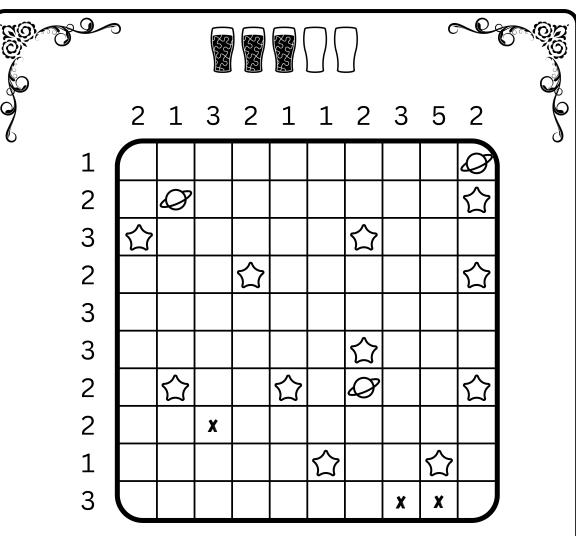




Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star

Twinkle, twinkle, little star, Tell me where your planets are. Seems like cosmic luck, it's true, Each star has exactly two. Find our neighbours way up high, Where should we now cast an eye?

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Place planets in the grid so that:

- Each star has exactly 2 planets next to it (including diagonally).
- Each planet is next to exactly 1 star.
- The number of planets in each row and column match the numbers outside of the grid.

Some planets and empty spaces have been given to get you started. When you find the others, you can flag the systems in your star chart.
