

People around the table: Aggie, Butch, Dolly, Jesse, Merle, Patsy, Tammy


Clues:





3. Wind Changes (1/2)

Life is tough 'round these parts. On the whole, it's easier when you're paired up.








3. Wind Changes (2/2)



Round up your partners, top to bottom, left to right!






4. Hexy Mountains

When you're an outlaw traveling through the rugged ranges out west, there's no telling who might **turn up**.






